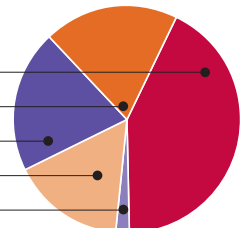

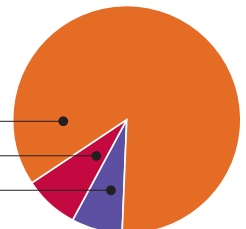
FY 2016–17 BUDGET \$17,345,000
