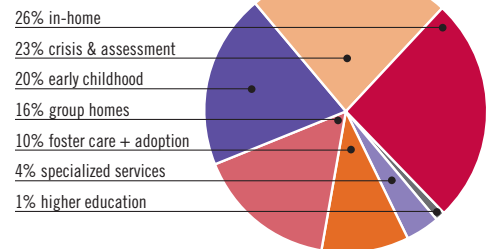
MODEL OF CARE

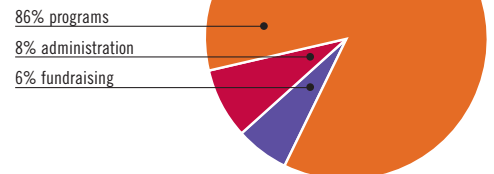
